DUPONT STREET PARKING LOT SNOW REMOVAL CONTRACT 2021-2022

Responsibilities: Plow and salt Dupont Street Parking Lot Premises: 514 Dupont Street, Philadelphia, PA 19128

Enactment: Begin with the first snowfall in the 2021-22 winter season and end on May 30, 2022. Contractor will plow and salt the above mentioned Premises, including the entrance and exit driveways, the pedestrian walkway, the sidewalk in front of the parking lot, and area around pay station. After the initial salting (when lot is first plowed), contractor will consult with Roxborough Development Corporation before re-salting the entire parking lot. However, contractor should salt the aforementioned area around both the entrance and exit driveways, the sidewalk in front of parking lot, the pedestrian walkway and area around pay station as the contractor deems necessary.

Measurement: For purposes of determining the total charges due, measurements shall be based on the snowfall report issued by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's National Weather Service for Northwest Philadelphia.
